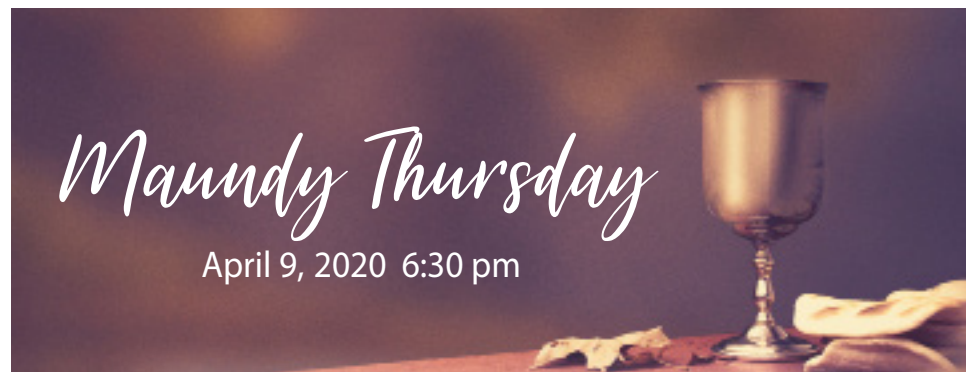

Celebrant: This is the night that Christ the Son of Man gathered with his disciples in the upper room.

This is the night that Christ our God gave us this holy feast, that we who eat this bread and drink this cup may here proclaim his perfect sacrifice.

Stripping of the Altar

Each Maundy Thursday, the Altar Guild carefully remove the candles, vessels, fine linens and paraments from the altar. Silence is observed during the Stripping of the Altar. This ancient and somber ceremony reminds us of Jesus, who on the night of his betrayal laid aside his woven tunic and tied a towel around his waist. He stripped for service. Another Gospel tells us that later "they stripped him" for mockery and death. The altar reminds us of Jesus—during Holy Week, all will be being taken from him as he enters his time of suffering and death.

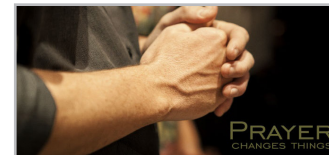
24 Hour Prayer Vigil
