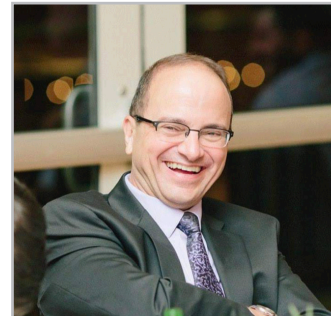
### Wednesday Evening Worship Through Song
