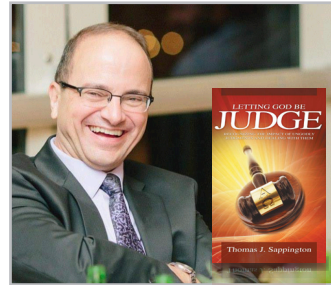
Drive Through Eucharist
